


Above: An example of a page from 'Pictograms, Icons & Signs', a book I used incessantly. 'Ritual' only uses imagery from this book.


To replicate the lion I used a projector, a first in my time painting. It made the job a lot easier and effective, producing a satisfying outcome.


















Entrance







My method for creating 'Entrance' was different to the other works. Instead of painting on one bit of canvas I painted on multiple shreds I had stapled onto the wall. I then glued them together onto a piece of found board. This was a way of experimenting by making each part a painting in-itself, and, when combined, creating a new, more abstract-form of expression.
